Class Performance Rubric

A. Group responsibility

Expert teams are responsible for dividing up responsibilities so that each member performs a roughly equivalent amount of work. This is a requirement for sharing the group project grade.

Expert teams are responsible for:

- a) becoming experts in, and drafting, their part of the class regulatory project;
- b) leading the class discussion regarding the cases corresponding to their expertise (fact development, regulatory details, and coordination will make different presentations) and ensuring the class understands the key principles related to their area.

B. Individual responsibility

Individuals are required to collaborate with their groups and with the other teams. They are also individually responsible for components of the group project and briefing cases assigned to them by their group within their area of expertise. All members of the class are also individually responsible for understanding the law (from the casebook) and will be tested individually by late midterm.
